

HotTub Rules and Operation

Hours of Use: 10 AM to 10 PM Daily

RULES FOR USE:

- 1. Entry to and exit from the pool area is by your personal gate card and only by you. Any Otherwise use may result in deactivation of your card number, which can be done even without your card. The gate will close and lock after you enter. Do not prop the gate open for anyone else to enter. At this time, your card is needed to exit the pool area. Keep it with your possessions where it will not become lost. Guest must be accompanied by a unit owner at all times within the pool area and to use any facilities within.**
- 2. It is recommended Individual Use of the HotTub and the Pool be minimized. Enjoyment with friend(s) is recommended so if a situation occurs another person will be available.**
- 3. Shower before using the HotTub. At this time, the changing rooms at the pool area are not in use. Renovation will be a part of the new Pool-House.
Oils, lotions or fragrances, including suntan oil or lotion are not to be used when entering the HotTub. Skin and clothing are to be free of such products.**
- 4. No glass containers of any type are allowed within the fenced area of the pool.**
- 5. Alcoholic beverage in cans or boxed such as wine may be consumed in moderation but not in the HotTub itself, only in the adjacent area. A seating area has been designed and will be will be implemented.**
- 6. No food is to be consumed in the HotTub or adjacent area.**

A POOL GATE CARD HAS BEEN ISSUED TO EACH UNIT AND THE CARD # IS RECORDED.

IF YOU LOOSE YOUR CARD YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO REPORT THIS TO A BOARD MEMBER. YOUR CARD IS REQUIRED TO OPEN THE GATE TO EXIT. IF AVAILABLE, ONE OF THEM WILL COME TO THE POOL GATE AND OPEN IT FOR YOU. IF UNAVAILABLE, PHONE A FRIEND AND HAVE THEM OPEN THE GATE FOR YOU.

TO REPLACE A LOST GATE CARD THE COST IS \$50. INFORM YOUR TENANTS. THE LOST CARD WILL BE DEACTIVATED.

RULES FOR OPERATION:

1. The HotTub Cover has a locking mechanism and lift system. To operate do the following:
 - a) Open the black and gray Lock Box located on the wall above an electrical outlet by punching these numbers in sequence— 2 then 5 then 8 then 0
 - b) Slide the top black OPEN button downward and while continuing to hold the button downward remove the gray cover to get the key for the locks on the HotTub Cover
 - c) Insert the key into these two locks and turn the key to release the locks
 - d) Install the gray cover back on the Lock Box after replacing the key using the same sequence while holding the black OPEN button downward then replace the cover
 - e) If you release the top black OPEN button before removing or replacing the box cover then slide the bottom black CLEAR button to reset the key pad and try again

Replace the HotTub cover upon departure. **DO NOT STAND OR SIT ON THE COVER.**

2. The HotTub jets and options are user controlled features. Return the controls and features to the settings you found upon arrival.
3. Lighting. The new overhead light is approved for use over the HotTub and is dimmable by use of the wall switch. Turn off the light when leaving. Additional lighting may be added as a part of the decorative features this spring.
4. Emergency shut-off of electrical system. Located on the wall outside the HotTub area is an emergency shut of electricity to the HotTub.
